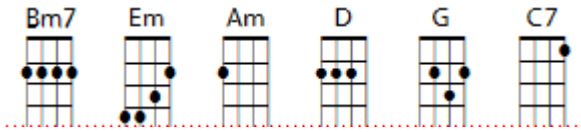


Can't Buy Me Love by the Beatles
