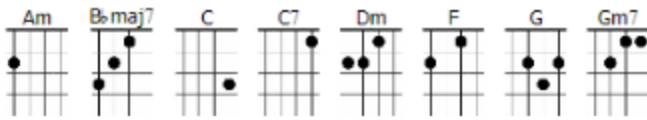


Fire And Rain
