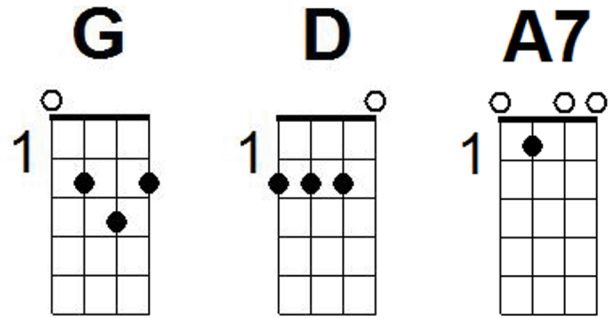


# This Land is Your Land (Woody Guthrie)
