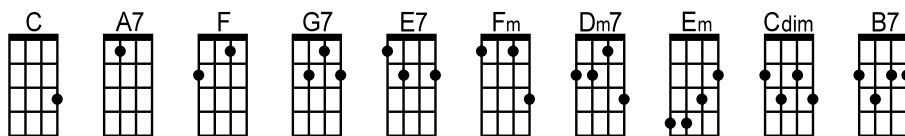


Tiptoe Through the Tulips (Al Dubin & Joe Burke)
