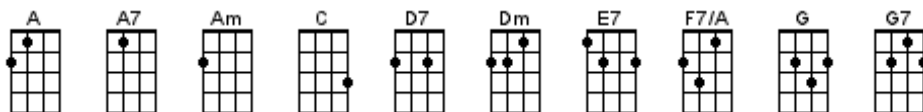


Lover, Come Back to Me
