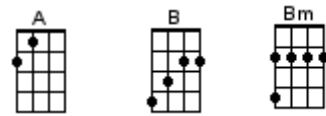

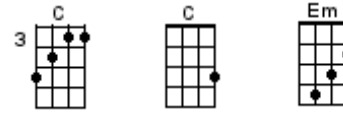
Spoken:

I laid my heart on the line

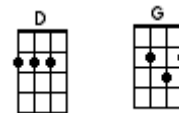


Intro: [G] / [C] [D] x 2
