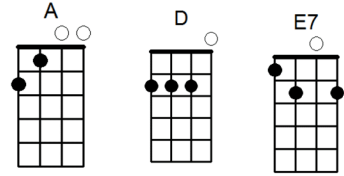


Another Saturday Night (Sam Cooke)
