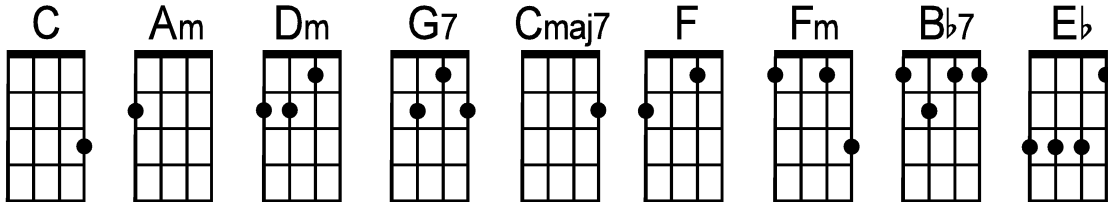


# Blue Moon
