

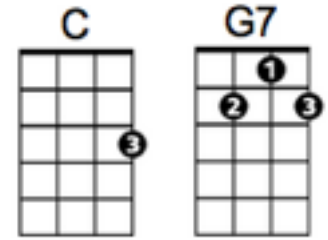

backbeat strum (d D d D d D d D) per chord

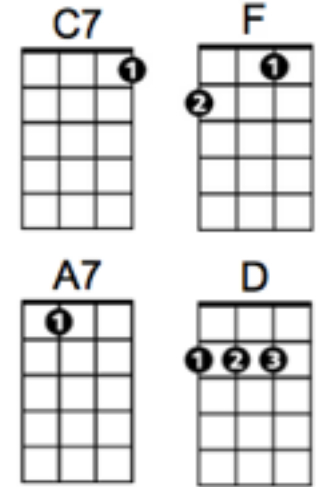
on [D - G7], split the measure and play [d D d D - d D d D]

VERSE:

C **C**

C7 **F**
