


















Comments:

- 1. R2 means that the root of the chord form is under the finger on the 2^{nd} string. For example, on F#m7, the note on the 2^{nd} string is F#. Therefore, any minor 7^{th} with this chord form will have its root on the 2^{nd} string.
- 2. Suggestion for practice: Play the two chords on the left twice (2 beats for each chord), then the chords on the right twice, and then repeat. This is the beginning of "Satin Doll."
