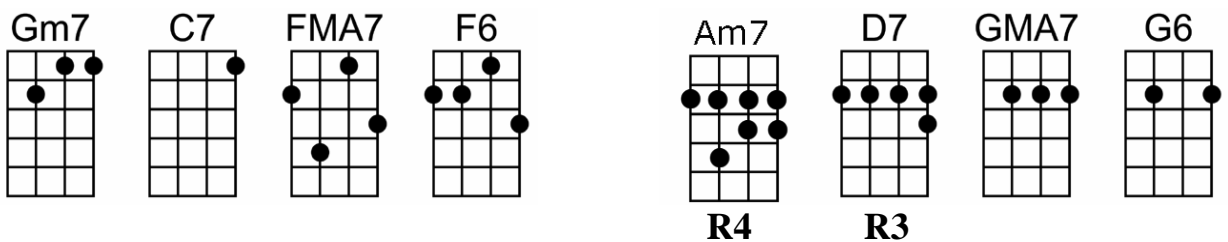
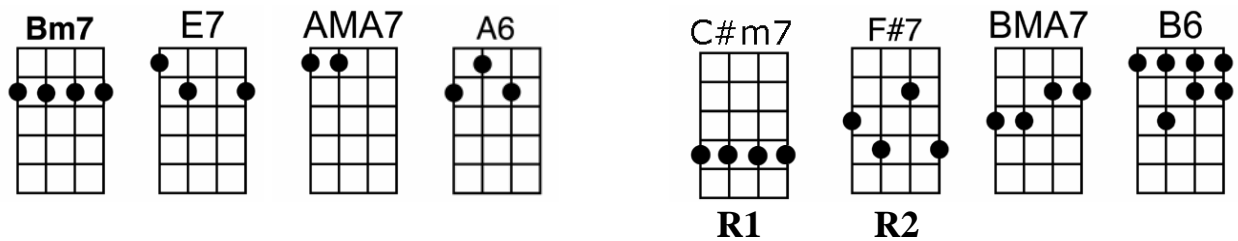
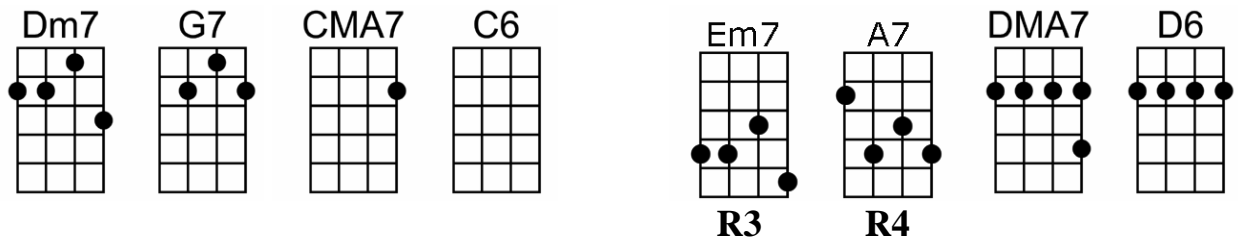
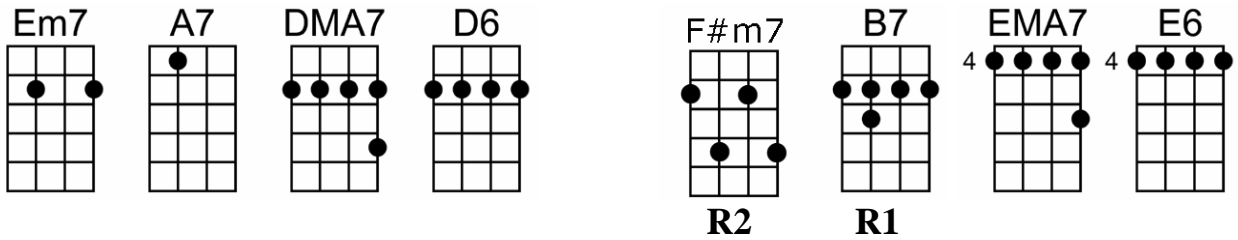


MINOR 7th to DOMINANT 7th to Major 7th and Major 6th (iim7 to V7 to I maj 7 and I 6)



Comments:

R2 means that the root of the chord form is under the finger on the 2nd string. For example, on F#m7, the note on the 2nd string is F#. Therefore, any minor 7th with this chord form will have the root on the 2nd string.
