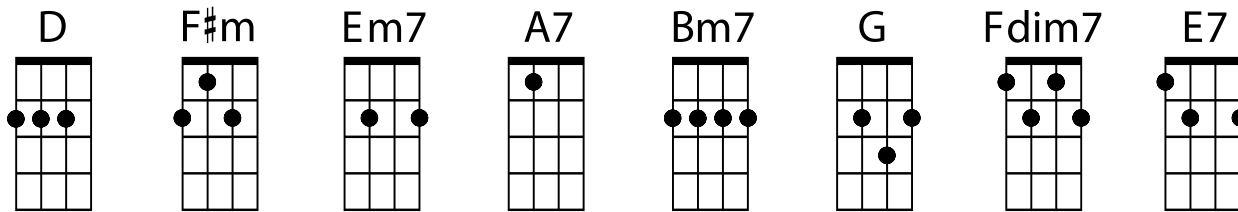


High Hopes (Key of D)
