Intro: F Am Bb F Bb F A7 Dm Bb / C7 / F Bb C7 /

F Am Bb F
I see trees of green, red roses, too,
Bb F A7 Dm

F Am Bb F
I see skies of blue, clouds of white,
Bb F A7 Dm
The bright blessed days and the dark sacred nights,
Bb / C / F Bb F /
And I think to myself, - "What a wonderful world."

Bridge

C / F /
The colours of the rainbow, so bright up in the sky,
C / F /
Are also on the faces of people passing by.
Dm Am Dm Am
I see friends shaking hands, saying, "How do you do?"
Dm Am Gm C7
They're really saying, "I love you."

F Am Bb F
I hear babies cry, and watch them grow
Gm F A7 Dm
They'll learn much more than I'll ever know,
Bb / C / F / / (/)
And I think to myself, - "What a wonderful world."

Solo: F Am Bb F Bb F A7 Dm Bb / C7 / F Bb F /
