that the attraction was purely physical

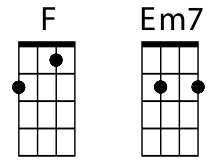

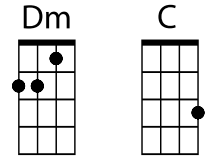
